Course Description:

The 6th grade ELA course is designed to improve the students' reading, writing, speaking, listening, and viewing skills. We will focus on integrating all aspects of language arts into one cohesive entity in order to show the students that learning is interwoven between all content areas. All students will be required to comprehend more challenging books and articles, using relevant text evidence to support analysis, inferences and claims. Expression of this comprehension will take place both in writing and in speech. 6th grade students will begin to tackle more technical and informational texts as well as continuing to study literary fiction and poetry.

- Citing textual evidence in support of text analysis
- Determining the theme or central idea of a text
- Analyzing both literary and informational texts
- Understanding an author's use of words and phrases in a text
- Analyzing the structure of a text
- Examining and explaining an author's point of view in a text
- Comparing and contrasting elements within, and presentations of, a text, multiple texts
- Evaluating an argument
- Writing effective summaries, arguments that use relevant evidence to support a claim, informational essays examining a topic, and descriptive well-structured narratives
- Engaging in effective collaborative discussions
